Dear Mr. Broyles:

As agreed, I am responding to your letter dated May 26, 2009, and specifically your request that the County rescind the Administrative Warning/Cease and Desist Order issued to Pastor David Jones on April 14, 2009.

The case file has been reviewed and additional information has been provided by various individuals involved in the case. Our current understanding of the scope of the activity held at the Jones' residence as conveyed in your May 26<sup>th</sup> letter to the County is as follows:

- *"David and Mary Jones began hosting a weekly Bible study fellowship in their home approximately five years ago."*
- *"The attendance at the weekly Bible study ranges from between five and twenty-seven people, but averages fifteen."*

- *"Most of the time the weekly meeting is comprised of dinner, fellowship and Bible study, but occasionally the meeting merely consists of dinner."*
- *"The Joneses have, on average, fifteen persons at their home on Tuesday evenings, resulting in only seven or eight additional vehicles. The Joneses, whose home is on a large lot, could for example be asked to have their guests park their cars on their property and completely off the street. Or, the Joneses could have their guests park elsewhere and shuttle them in via carpool or van or bus."*


Based upon the above information, the County has determined that the weekly activity is within the scope of the residential use and the Joneses are willing and able to accommodate any concerns that may arise with respect to parking. Therefore, the County hereby rescinds the Administrative Warning/Cease and Desist Order issued in Case No. 09-50536 [DPLU – 40576]. The County agrees that a major use permit is not required for the activity described in your May 26<sup>th</sup> letter.

Thank you for your professional courtesy and cooperation in this matter.
